RefWorks

There are two RefWorks versions that a Library may have today. The following chart summarizes all the capabilities and differences between these versions. Please review the differences and note that by the end of 2019 those marked with an * will no longer be available for Lite users.

1) Lite version of RefWorks: This basic version enables users to create permanent RefWorks accounts to save and organize references into folders, and generate citations and bibliographies. This version is only made available in specific cases such as when bundled with other products, however it does not offer the same feature set as full institutional RefWorks.

2) Full institutional version of RefWorks: A full institutional subscription to RefWorks delivers more value to researchers and libraries than the lite version. Researchers can take advantage of significant individual research management tools, combining all the capabilities available through the lite version of RefWorks with additional features such as advanced search, Word and Google Docs add-ins, support for sharing and institutional collections and more. Libraries benefit from institutional reporting capabilities and customer support.
