Key peer-reviewed academic and independent journals from the region, effortless access and broad coverage gives CEEOL's collection its unique value and high quality.

BROAD COVERAGE OF CEE/SEE RELEVANT CONTENT

As of March 2021, CEEOL covered around 2,400 Humanities journal titles with 723,000+ articles published in more than 30 languages. The CEEOL coverage is growing monthly by 4,000 newly included journal articles. Significant number of the included journals are represented with complete archival collection.

The CEEOL eBook collection development has started in 2016 and offers access to more than 5,000 eBooks, as well current year as backlists of the partnering publishing houses.

The CEEOL Grey Literature Collection project includes 6,300 Grey Literature items.
