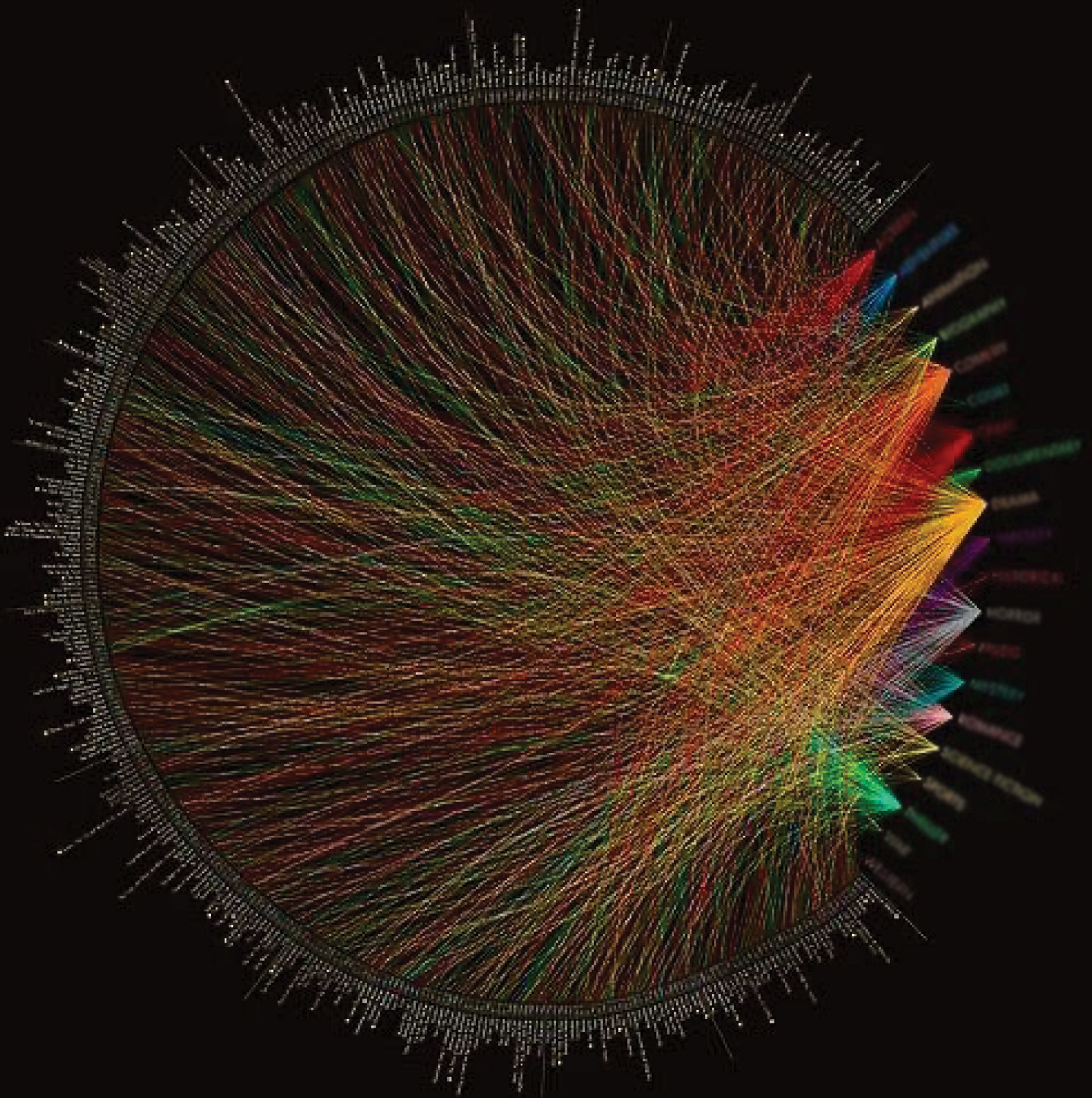

# Demonstrate your research impact in the real world

**Coherent Impact** is a real-world impact intelligence platform that reveals how research is used across policy, practice, and applied settings. It supports REF-style impact narratives, grant justification, translational research, and equity-driven global relevance. It covers 40 million items from more than 33,000 organizations.

**Coherent Impact** helps universities demonstrate influence in society and the economy—and makes it easy to align research with funder priorities.

## What tools does it provide?

Use robust tools for discovering, tracking, and evidencing real-world research, such as advanced Boolean search, rich metadata filters, and permanent identifiers to find where research is cited, reused, and embedded.

In Q2 2026, we will be launching new additional tools to track citations from policy and practice documents to scholarly research outputs. Analyze, assess, and report which organizations, sectors, and geographies are citing your work. Explore citation contexts to see not just *what* was cited but *why*.

**13,000 Think Tanks, NGOs and Nonprofits:** Trace academic ideas from large-scale testing to applied results, evaluations, and real-world programs—often ahead of formal policy adoption.

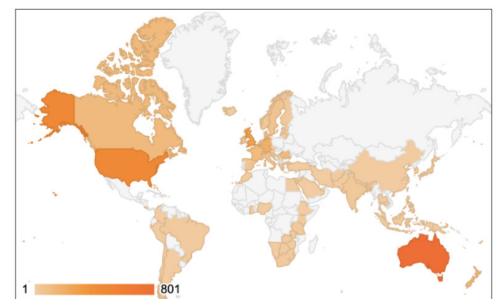
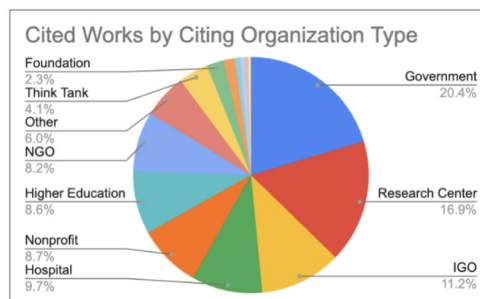
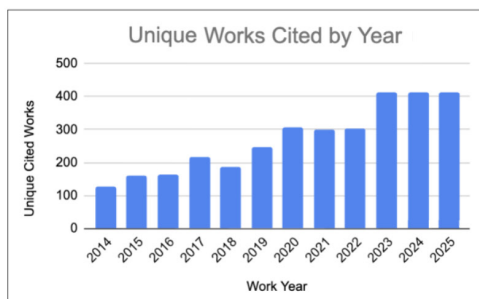
**6,500 Organizations from the Global South:** Show global relevance and equity by tracking research uptake across institutions tackling frontline policy, health, and development challenges.

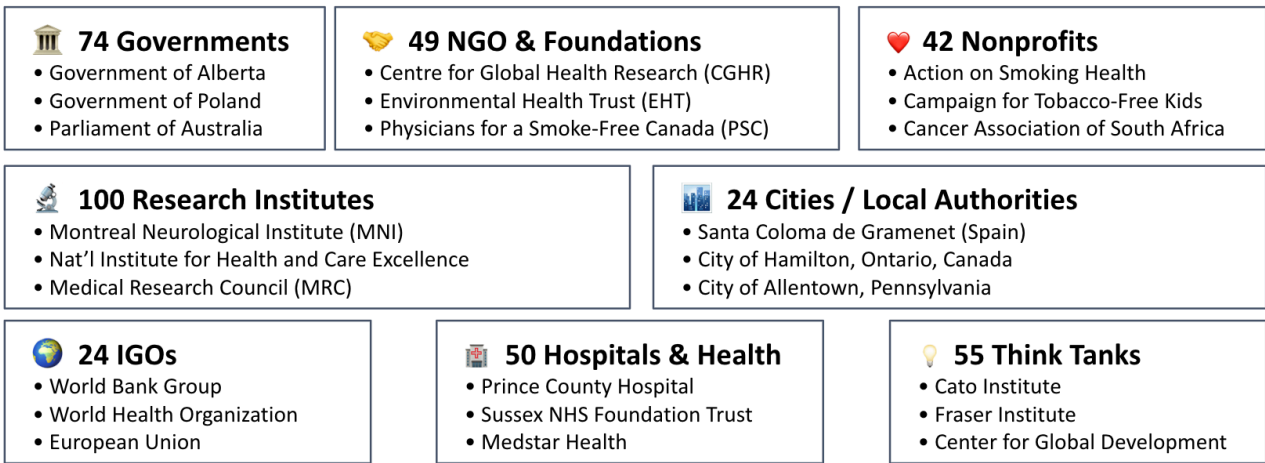

**4,000 Local Governments:** Show local impact, civic engagement and public ROI by tracking how research adopted by states, cities, and municipalities is incorporated, plans, and operating standards—evidence local funders increasingly demand.

**700 Corporations:** Show relevance for commerce, innovation, and productivity improvements by tracking research adopted in product decisions, standards, and innovation practice

**400,000 Podcasts, Videos, and Blogs:** Trace how research shapes public discourse, professional practice, and policy debate across new media—often faster and further than through formal publications.

### Who is it for?

**Libraries:** Expand collections to capture real-world policy and practice-based research beyond journal coverage. Enable impact assessment for researchers and administrators, while complementing traditional citation databases with real-world evidence others exclude.

**Research Offices:** Document and communicate how institutional research is taken up in policy, programs, and practice. Support real-world impact reporting, evaluation, and strategy. Find funding opportunities.

**Researchers:** See where your work informs real-world decisions. Discover new sources missing from your research. Understand how research is used outside academia.
