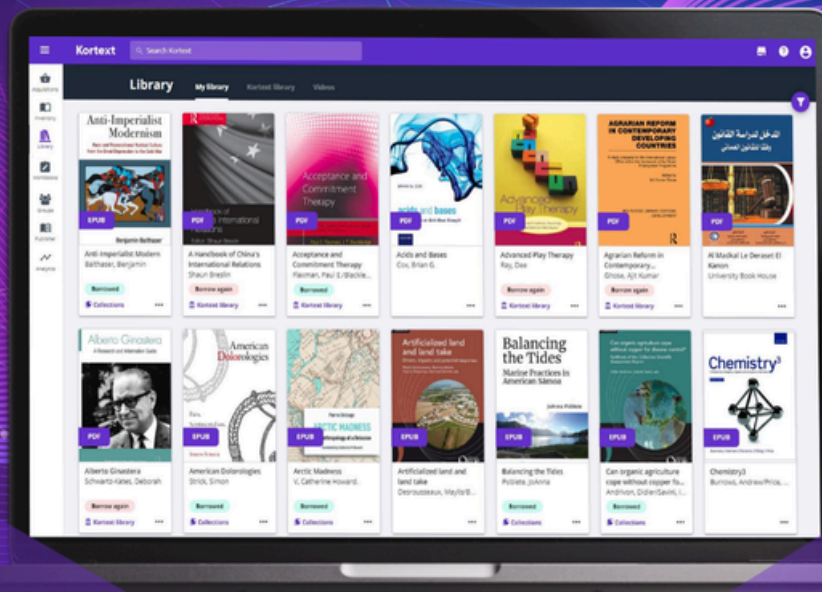

Introduction

If you are accessing via the specified IP range for your institution, you will be able to see the Anonymous View of the Kortext reader and platform, which has limited features.

You will have the option to create your own account to see the Authenticated View of the reader and platform, to access personalised reader and platform features such as notes, bookmarks and your personalized bookshelf.

How to access

If you are within the specified IP range, you can [click here](#) to gain access to the Anonymous View of our platform, our Kortext bookshelf.

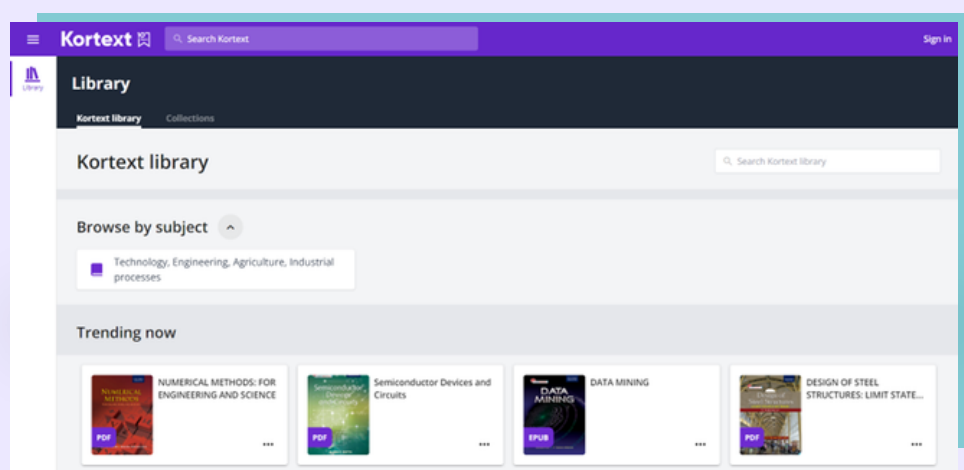
This will take you to our terms and conditions screen, where you can review and accept through the checkbox, which will allow you to click the 'Start Reading' option to proceed to the Anonymous View of Kortext.

Your institution may also provide direct links to titles within the library catalogue, that you can also use to access the book within the reader directly.

Anonymous View

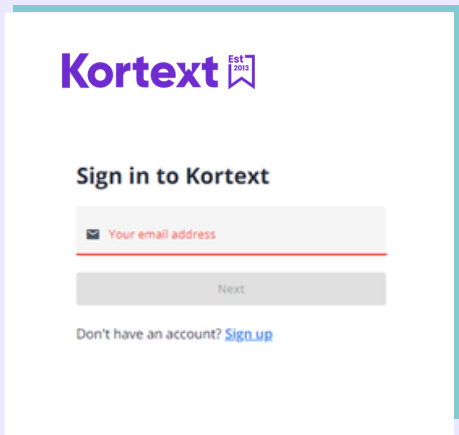
The Anonymous View of the Kortext platform has limited options available; you will only have access to the 'Library' icon, which will include 'Kortext Library' and/or 'Collections' through which you can view the titles that are available to your institution.

You can create your own Kortext account or sign into an existing one to access the Authenticated View of our platform by clicking the 'Sign in' option in the below example of an Anonymous View:

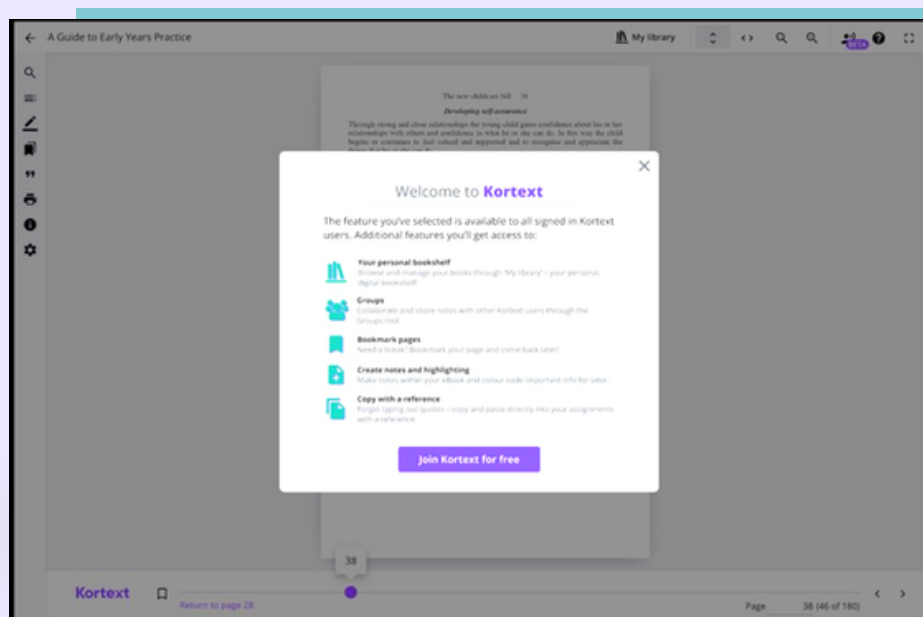
This will take you to the following sign in/sign up screen, where you can either enter the email address of an existing Kortext account to sign in, or create an account with the 'Sign up' option:

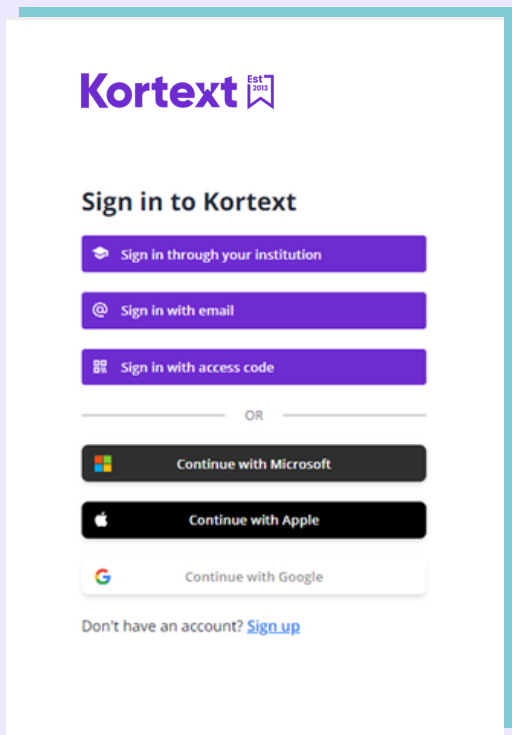


If you choose to click on one of the book thumbnails, before creating an account, you will be taken to the Anonymous View of the Kortext reader, where you can read the selected title.

Anonymous View – Kortext reader

The Anonymous View of the Kortext reader will look the same as the Authenticated View; however if you attempt to access a personalised feature, such as bookmarks, notes or highlights, you will be prompted to create an account. You can do so by selecting the 'Join Kortext for Free' option:





This will take you to the following sign in/sign up screen, where you should select the sign up option to create a new Kortex account, or sign into an existing account with the 'Sign in with email' option:



Features available for each view

The following features are available within the Anonymous View:

- General navigation within the reader using the navigation arrows, the slider bar and the table of contents.
- The search function within the reader.
- Basic access to titles available to your institution through the 'Kortex Library' and 'Collections' tabs within our platform (Kortex bookshelf).

Within the Authenticated View, you can gain access to further features, such as:

- The personalised Kortex bookshelf ('My Library').
- The groups function.
- Bookmarking, note creation and highlighting within the Kortex reader.
- Reference functions within the Kortex reader.
- Printing and copying.
